Basildon's distinguished school uniform reflects our high expectations of academic excellence and character development. The uniform is fully inclusive and allows for religious observation. All pupils must dress according to the Uniform Policy without exception and this includes PE kit.

Final decisions on the suitability of uniform are made by staff and we expect parents to support these decisions in full.

If any parent needs support to provide a full uniform, they should discuss this with the Headteacher. The school will always be considerate and try to assist. Pupils will not be made to feel uncomfortable, nor discriminated against, because their parents are unable to provide them with school uniform.

Please ensure all clothing and property is clearly labelled. This enables pupils to identify their clothing and allows for articles to be traced and returned.

The school does not accept responsibility for loss or damage of school uniform.

The school actively promotes the use of second-hand uniform, we believe that the good quality of our uniform makes it longer lasting. The school has second hand uniform shop which is accessible by parents at any time.

The school recognises that purchasing any school uniform can be costly and offers financial support with this to any family who needs it.

Footwear:

Pupils must wear closed-toed, hard-soled all black, plain shoe with a flat sole and no emblems. Boots and slip-on shoes are not allowed.

Hairstyles:

Pupils' hair should be neat at all times. Hair below shoulder length should be tied back using discreet school coloured hair bands. Pupils may not wear designs or words cut into their hair.

Nail polish or make-up:

Pupils are not allowed to wear nail polish or false nails. Make-up is not allowed.

Piercings:

Piercings are prohibited with the exception of single, standard ear piercing, which will need to be removed or covered with surgical tape during PE. Where needed, parents must provide the surgical tape.
